

Air Permitting Update



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Major Facility to Minor Facility

- Pre-application meeting to review the proposal
- If accepting any limitations, then Sig. Mod.
- If removing any equipment, then Minor Mod.
- Enforcement review
- Submit Preconstruction Permit (PCP)
- After PCP issuance, Title V terminated

Annual Certification Issuance

- For each applicable requirement, submit certification within 60 days after each calendar year
- Submit certification electronically through online NJDEP web portal

- Submission should be printed for submission to EPA

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- For each applicable requirement
 - Statement weather compliance is continuous or intermittent, as defined in federal rules
 - Compliance schedule
 - Compliance with any ACO, if applicable
 - Not in compliance
 - Certification by Responsible Official

Emission Statement

- Submit an annual emission statement (if required) electronically to the NJDEP by May 15 of each year (or by mutually agreed upon date, but no later than June 15 of each year).

- Administrative Completeness
- Technical Completeness and review
- Compliance Plan
- Public Process

Temporary Mobile Equipment

- Allowed for short term for 90 days
 - Not installed or used permanently
 - Not circumvent any state or federal rules and performance standards
 - Must obtain PCP and comply with all terms and conditions specified
 - Operate less than 90 days in any calendar years
 - Record of all temporary mobile equipment on site, date, time and emissions

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- Emissions must be included in netting analysis required by the facility
- If such short term activities re-occur on at least annual basis, permittee is required to include in Title V permit within one year of the first use, through permit modification

 - SEGAP
 - CHP < 65 MMBTU/Hr, CT
 - CHP < 65 MMBTU/Hr, Reciprocating SI Engine

GP/GOP Development Schedule

- GP-001A – Storage Silos
 - Public Comment Period Ended 8/15/13
 - Testing Ended 2/27/15
 - Rollout 4/20/15
- GP-005B and GOP-004 NG Emergency Generators
 - Public Comment Period Ended 12/17/14
 - Rollout (on paper form) 5/4/15***
 - Development starts 3/15/15
 - Testing begins 6/15/15
 - Rollout 8/3/15

GP/GOP Development Schedule (more)

- GP-017A and GOP-007 Boilers <5 MMBTU/Hr
 - Public Comment Period Ended End of May
 - Development starts Beg of June
 - Testing begins Mid September
 - Rollout December
