Hazardous Waste Checklists and Compliance Assistance Materials Now Available Via the Internet

Who is affected by this initiative?

Any company/business that generates waste materials considered to be hazardous based on either exhibiting characteristics, such as ignitability; reactivity; corrosivity or toxicity, or being listed in the Code of Federal Regulations as a hazardous waste from a specific process or an off-specification chemical product.

Why would I need help?

This new web page offers helpful guidelines for rules that may apply to your facility, as well as quick links to the actual regulations. In addition, there are contact names and phone numbers that can assist you in getting to the right person when you have a question.
