Online Decal Renewal Information for Solid and Hazardous Waste Transporters

Who is affected by this advisory?

All NJDEP Registered Solid, Medical, and Hazardous Waste Transporters.

Why is DEP issuing this advisory?

The currently issued NJDEP Transporter decals will expire on June 30, 2015. These decals must be renewed online using a web-based online service and cannot be renewed by phone or through the mail.

What is DEP doing?

The DEP will send notification e-mails to each waste transporter with information on the upcoming renewal cycle.

What should I do?

Go to the Licensing & Registration online renewal web page at <http://www.nj.gov/dep/dshw/hwr/regislic/lru.htm>, and follow the links to the online renewal service.

Companies with 10 vehicles or less will be able to renew online using a simplified process that does not require the creation of an online account. This service also allows registering additional equipment but only allows payment by credit card.

Companies with more than 10 vehicles (or if any equipment is leased) will need to create an NJDEP Online account in order to complete the renewal. This service is more complex but offers several advantages such as payment by e-check or through the mail.

In order to receive decals before the expiration date of June 30, 2015, you must complete and pay for your renewal by May 1, 2015.

All transporters are required to have the following credentials:

- A valid commercial motor vehicle registration for each Cab, Trailer or Single Unit Vehicle.
- Valid insurance with the appropriate level of coverage, which may include an MCS-90.

- Proper registration with the Department of the Treasury, the Secretary of State, and/or the Office of Consumer Affairs Business Formation or Registration Certification Office(s).
- Hazardous waste transporters and interstate solid waste transporters must have an in-service carrier USDOT number. In addition, hazardous waste transporters must have a current PHMSA registration and an MCS-90 showing insurance that meets the basic requirements listed in 49 CFR Part 387 - specifically \$1,000,000 to \$5,000,000 of coverage.
- A-901 licensed companies must comply with all A-901 and Certification of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) annual filing requirements and fee submittals.

Please note the following:

- Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 54:50-24 et seq, the NJDEP is obligated to provide your information to the Director of the New Jersey Division of Taxation to assist in the administration and enforcement of State tax law.
- The DEP will no longer issue Registration Cards for Hazardous Waste Containers.
- All documents and certifications related to your NJDEP Vehicle Registration renewal must be kept up-to-date and on file at your office, since NJDEP may request them later.
