Dear New Jersey Summer Flounder Permit Holder:
New Jersey Summer Flounder Dealer:

As of May 27, 2008 the Division of Fish and Wildlife has determined that approximately 127,183 pounds of summer flounder have been landed since the May/June season opened on May 1, 2008. Based upon this information and pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:25-18.12(i), the New Jersey by-catch summer flounder fishery will be closed as of 8:00 PM Saturday, May 31, 2008. For similar reasons, the New Jersey directed summer flounder fishery was closed on May 21, 2008.

Effective 8:01 PM, May 31, 2008 no vessel shall land or possess nor shall any dealer accept ANY summer flounder.

On July 1, 2008 the by-catch summer flounder fishery will re-open with a by-catch trip limit of 100 pounds. By-catch landings may not exceed ten percent, by weight, of all species landed and sold. The directed summer flounder fishery will re-open on July 6, 2008 with a 500 pound trip limit with a maximum of four landings per week.
