### Become a Sedge Island Intern!

More than 500 adults and students participate in a Sedge Island program each season. As an intern you will be able inspire and excite participants about New Jersey's natural resources through conservation education.

### **Position Duration:** June – August, some weekends in spring and fall if possible.

Location: Sedge Island Natural Resource Education Center is located off of Island Beach State Park, Seaside Park, NJ in Barnegat Bay.

### Job Duties:

- Assist with teaching adults and students in an outdoor classroom setting about New Jersey's estuarine natural resources.
- Assist with group activities, including orientation, meal preparation, and cleaning prior to group departure. (This requires staying overnight on the island.)
- Help maintain program equipment and help keep the Sedge House organized.

**Benefits:** This is a volunteer (unpaid) internship however, you will:

- gain experience in environmental and cultural interpretation
- learn about flora and fauna of the salt marsh
- interact with some of New Jersey's top biologists
- earn college internship credit, if applicable to your school and degree program
