Dear New Jersey Black Sea Bass Permit Holder: New Jersey Black Sea Bass Dealer:

The New Jersey Division of Fish and Wildlife has determined that the Season 2 (April 16 – June 30) directed black sea bass quota of 110,527 pounds will be harvested by May 15, 2014. Based upon this information and pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:25-18.12(h), the New Jersey directed black sea bass fishery will be closed as of 8:00 PM, Thursday, May 15, 2014.

Effective 8:01 PM, Thursday, May 15, 2014, no vessel shall land or possess and no dealer shall accept any black sea bass in excess of the by-catch trip limit of 50 pounds through June 30, 2014 or until such time as the seasonal by-catch is projected to be taken. By-catch landings may not exceed ten percent, by weight, of all species landed and sold.

The directed black sea bass fishery will re-open on July 1, 2014, with directed trip limit options of 500 pounds six times a week or 1,000 pounds three times a week or 3,000 pounds once a week. If you have any questions, please contact the Bureau of Marine Fisheries at 609-748-2020.
