

# 2014 Sedge Island Student Programs



## Sedge Island Fishing Experience — June 26-29, 2014

The NJDEP Division of Fish and Wildlife, in partnership with Conserve Wildlife Foundation of NJ, is offering a 4-day 3-night program open to students going into grades 8 and 9 in the fall of 2014. Students will spend the first three days fishing the area while learning about the surrounding ecosystem. On the final night a parent or guardian will join the group and spend time learning from the students, and the following day fishing with them.

Cost is \$475\* and includes all meals, lodging, instruction and equipment.

## Sedge Island Field and Research Experience — July 10-16, 2014

NJDEP Division of Fish and Wildlife, in partnership with the Marine Academy of Technology and Environmental Science (MATES), is offering a residential research experience for students going into grades 10 and 11 in the fall of 2014. During this program students will be taught field research skills that will lead them to conduct team research projects on the Barnegat Bay with a culmination of a sharing session the last day of the program. The Lighthouse Center in Waretown and the Sedge Island Natural Resource Education Center in Seaside Park will be the settings for where research will take place.

Cost is \$770\* and includes all meals, lodging, instruction and equipment.



## Sedge Island Field Experience — July 28-31, 2014

The NJDEP Division of Fish and Wildlife, in partnership with Conserve Wildlife Foundation of NJ, is offering a 4-day 3-night program open to students going into grades 7, 8 and 9 in the fall of 2014. Students will spend their days immersed in the salt marshes of Barnegat Bay while exploring the ecosystem by kayak, living a conservationist lifestyle, and learning first hand about research from biologists.

Cost is \$425\* and includes all meals, lodging, instruction and equipment.
