Dear New Jersey Summer Flounder Permit Holder:
New Jersey Summer Flounder Dealer:

As determined by New Jersey's commercial summer flounder landing records, the New Jersey Division of Fish and Wildlife anticipates the 2015 Season 4 (July-August) directed quota of 177,838 pounds of summer flounder will be landed by Saturday, August 15, 2015. Based upon this information and pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:25-18.12(i), the New Jersey 2015 Season 4 directed summer flounder fishery will be closed as of 8:00 PM (Saturday), August 15, 2015.

Effective 8:01 PM, August 15, 2015 no vessel shall land or possess nor shall any dealer accept any summer flounder in excess of the by-catch trip limit of 100 pounds through August 31, 2015 or until such time as the Season 4 by-catch is projected to be taken. By-catch landings may not exceed ten percent, by weight, of all species landed and sold.

The 2015 Season 5 (September-October) by-catch fishery will open on September 1, 2015 with a by-catch trip limit of 100 pounds. By-catch landings may not exceed ten percent, by weight, of all species landed and sold.

The 2015 Season 5 (September- October) directed fishery will open on September 6, 2015 with a directed trip limit of 650 pounds 4 times a week or 2,500 pounds 1 time a week.
