## Pequest Trout Hatchery Rainbow Trout Life Cycle



The beginning of the cycle begins in late August/early September. Broodstock Rainbow Trout are sorted by sex. The females are checked weekly to see if their eggs are ripe.





When the female trout become ripe, the eggs are stripped and fertilized with milt from the males. This takes place weekly through October or until our egg quota is met. Eggs are then disinfected before being put in trays or incubation jars.



Approximately 1.5 million Rainbow Trout eggs are taken from roughly 600 females annually. Eggs take about 32 days to hatch.

After hatching, trout are reared in the Nursery Building until late March. They will start to be moved outside into the raceway system as the pools are cleaned as the previous Spring production fish are stocked. This process will take until June to complete.



Once trout are moved outside they will be sorted in the early spring and again late in the summer. Growth will continue to be monitored. Feed amounts and sizes are adjusted monthly to reach our final stocking goals for each stocking program.





Finally, after 18 months of rearing Rainbow Trout are ready for Spring Stocking in mid-March. After 24 months of rearing, trout for the Fall and Winter Programs are ready to be stocked. Selected trout are held to become 2 and 3 year-old broodstock to continue the cycle.
