IMPORTANT NOTICE

Report any suspicious mortality of white-tailed deer at your facility to the Captive Game Permit Office IMMEDIATELY at (908) 735-6398. Chronic Wasting Disease is characterized by emaciation. If Chronic Wasting Disease is suspected, preserve the retropharyngeal lymph nodes by removing the head and refrigerating (not freezing) the specimen.

Persons wishing to import captive game birds and game animals into NJ are required to apply for an Importation Permit prior to the importation and must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) not more than 30 days old. Game birds must be accompanied with documentation noting negative test results for Avian Influenza and Pullorum-Typhoid at the originating facility. Importation application forms and information are available on the Captive Game information webpage. Allow a minimum of 15 days to process the application.

Persons wishing to possess migratory bird species may be required to have a federal USFWS Special Purpose permit or a USFWS Waterfowl Sale & Disposal permit in addition to the NJ Captive Game

permit. Contact the USFWS Migratory Bird permitting office at (413) 253-8200 or visit the USFWS website at http://www.fws.gov/permits/overview/overview.html to review the requirements for keeping waterfowl and non-waterfowl game birds. It is your responsibility to obtain the appropriate federal permits in addition to your NJ Captive Game Permit.

Possession of captive game mammals may require a permit from USDA-APHIS Animal Care. Contact the USDA-APHIS Animal Care Unit in Raleigh, NC at (919)855-7100 for additional Game animals or game birds held under a Propagation and Sales permit type may be harvested and sold for food purposes, provided each carcass is tagged. Completed forms may be faxed to NJ Captive Game permits at (609) 259-8155 or emailed to Krista.Laws@dep.nj.gov. Animal exhibitor and theatrical permit holders must notify the Division in writing at least 2 weeks prior to any exhibition/performance so to allow for inspection. Notice must include: contact information; permit number; dates and times of performance/exhibit; name and address of the facility and/or location where the exhibition or event will take place.
