Dear Captive Game Permit Holders:

As you know, State offices continue to go "green" by reducing the amount of paper, energy, postage, staff time and associated costs by posting pertinent information and forms on the internet and making it readily available to the public.

- 1) Captive Game Animal and Game Bird Annual Report and Application Renewal form - has been posted on the Division's captive game web page at http://www.state.nj.us/dep/fgw/captivegame_info.htm
 - a. Please review the form to ensure the entire document has printed and includes the information at the top part of the form all the way down to return address on page 2.
 - b. Be sure to include your current e-mail address as the permits and other correspondence will be issued via e-mail when ever possible.
- 2) All other forms pertaining to captive wildlife have been updated and posted on the website.
 - a. As a reminder, those who hold certain types of permits (Animal exhibitors, Animal Theatrical, Zoological) are also required to complete and submit quarterly reports at the end of each quarter.
- 3) N.J.A.C. 7:25-4 and N.J.A.C. 7:25-10 requires proof of competent and adequate licensed veterinary services for care and treatment of the animals prior to the issuance of any permit. Therefore, we are also asking you to help update our files by simply completing and submitting the Consulting Veterinary Services Information Form with your Annual Report/Renewal Form. The form is located right under the Renewal form on the website.
- 4) Please note there are several changes to our mailing address (change in PO #, zip code and addition of a mail code). While the office is still in the same physical location, please be sure to use the new address for all correspondence.
- 5) Approximately 25% of the facilities holding captive wildlife have been inspected in the passed 18 months. If your facility has not been inspected recently, you may be contacted in the near future.
