

## Striped Mullet

Mugil cephalus



### **Description:**

- dark olive, brown or bluish above
- each scale on upper part of body has a dark spot at the base
- dark spots form stripes on side of fish
- large dark blotch at base of pectoral fin
- second dorsal fin begins directly above where anal fin begins
- body somewhat rounded toward head and compressed toward tail

#### Size:

up to 36 inches

### **Range**

 Nova Scotia to Brazil; absent in Bahamas, West Indies and Caribbean


#### **Facts**:

- migrate in large schools
- catadromous fish: spawn in saltwater yet spend most of life in freshwater
- spawn mid October to late January; peaking in November and December
- spawn off shore
- eggs hatch 48 hours after fertilization
- can be seen jumping to evade predators
