## MOUNTAIN BICYCLE POLICY

- 1. Mountain bicycles are permitted on all roads within wildlife management areas open to motor vehicle use on a year-round basis.
- 2. Mountain bicycles are permitted to use existing trails and secondary roads on wildlife management areas from March 1 to April 15, from June 1 to September 15, and on all Sundays throughout the year. The only exception to this policy is on the Assunpink WMA, where mountain bicycles will be permitted to use existing trails and secondary roads only between June 1 and August 30. Sunday riding will not be permitted except between June 1 and August 30.
- The use of mountain bicycles engaged in legal hunting and fishing activities and Division sponsored events will be permitted on a year round basis.
- 4. Mountain bicycles are prohibited from riding over any dam, wildlife food area, cultivated fields, lawns and gardens. Mountain bicycles are also prohibited from establishing any new trails through the destruction of existing vegetation.
- 5. Competitive mountain bicycles races and group events will not be permitted on wildlife management areas statewide.
