



NEW JERSEY'S 2009 ONLINE STRIPED BASS BONUS PROGRAM




Printed with this letter, you will receive a log-sheet for recording your striped bass fishing efforts and one, 2009 non-transferable bonus permit. Anglers must sign this permit upon receipt. No other cards or permits are valid for 2009.

New Jersey's Striped Bass Regulations:

-  **Two fish at 28" or greater in all New Jersey waters.**
-  Visit our website (www.njfishandwildlife.com) to check current Federal and State possession and season regulations for striped bass fishing in your area.








Striped Bass Bonus Program:

-  Participants are allowed one additional striped bass at 28" or greater.
-  One Bonus permit will be issued per person.
-  **Bonus permits are non-transferable and valid only for the 2009 calendar year. Only one permit is good per day.**

What to do if you harvest a bonus fish:

-  All information on the permit must be completed immediately after harvest and prior to transportation.
-  Report harvest information at www.wildlifelicenses.com. A \$2.00 fee will be charged to receive a replacement permit. Harvest information must be reported online for all permits issued via the internet. You will not receive a new permit by going to a check station or by mailing your permit to the Division.

Suggestions concerning filling out the fishing log:

-  If possible, the Division encourages all participants to use the online logbook to report all striped bass fishing activity in place of the paper logbooks.
-  Fill out the log for yourself only and list fishing days individually, not grouped together.
-  Record all striped bass fishing trips even if no stripers were caught.
-  Please measure all fish caught. This is extremely important! **NO SIZE RANGES!**
-  Make as many copies of the log as necessary or call for additional copies.
-  Keep the comments coming, especially those concerning the health of the stripers.
-  If you harvest a Bonus fish, please enter the used permit number onto the log in the additional information section.
