

## **Trail Highlights**

The true beauty of the Hyper-Humus section of the Paulinskill Wildlife Management Area is found in the peat ponds and plant diversity in its shrub layer. Many species of waterfowl can be viewd here, as can insects such as butterflies and dragonflies. This is the spot for Monarch Butterfly enthusiasts!

The pace is slow, covering approximately 1 mile every 45 minutes, with the entire round-trip hike lasting approximately 2.5 hours.
