### PROJECT NAME AND DESCRIPTION:

#### **ADAMS AVENUE BASIN, TOMS RIVER TOWNSHIP, OCEAN COUNTY**

This existing basin serves 227 acres within the watershed of Barnegat Bay. Accumulated sediments from the upstream developments have partially filled the detention basin and prevent it from functioning properly.

### GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE IN ACTION:

The project converted an existing detention basin into a permanent pond with native wetland vegetation. The permanent pool will provide sedimentation and the plants will enhance the water quality treatment of the pond.

### FUNDING:
