

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

TAKE NOTICE that the Township of Bordentown and the New Jersey Turnpike Authority has filed a request with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Green Acres Program, proposing to dispose of a portion of certain parklands located at Block 92, Lot 20, Block 92, Lot 21, Block 92.01, Lot 1, Block 93, Lot 3 and Block 93, Lot 10 in the Township of Bordentown, totaling approximately 5.87 acres in fee and 1.122 acres in easement, in connection with the New Jersey Turnpike 6-9 Widening Program, which consists of approximately 35 miles of road widening and associated interchange improvements from the vicinity of Interchange 6, in Mansfield Township, Burlington County (Milepost 48) to Interchange 9 in East Brunswick Township, Middlesex County (Milepost 83). As compensation for the proposed disposal of portions of Block 92, Lot 20, Block 92, Lot 21, Block 92.01, Lot 1, Block 93, Lot 3 and Block 93, Lot 10 in the Township of Bordentown, the Township of Bordentown will receive approximately seventeen (17) acres of Block 129, Lot 18 in the Township of Bordentown, to be used by the Township of Bordentown as dedicated public parkland subject to regulation by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Green Acres Program.
