### Internship Project Description:

Visualizing Elevated Ozone Air Pollution: Continue development of a 4D analysis framework animating the travel of an air parcel from its origin, using atmospheric conditions / weather patterns to track the parcel as it moves across the eastern U.S. Along the path precursor emissions are added, ultimately resulting in unhealthy ozone concentrations in New Jersey. This project involves the use of ArcGIS Pro software to obtain, develop, and depict factors contributing to ozone formation and moving the air parcel through time. The project will involve analyzing one to three episodes of high ozone concentrations important to the air quality in New Jersey and/or to the adjacent areas. The objective of this project is to develop a simple visual to help understand the many factors that affect ozone concentrations.

### Estimated Project Duration and Suggested Weekly Work Schedule:

To ensure sufficient time to complete the project, we require Interns work a minimum of 6 weeks with no less than 14 hours per week at the NJDEP in Trenton, NJ.
