

Instructions for Tidelands License Applications

A Tidelands license is a short term rental agreement from the State of New Jersey for the use of its tidelands. As defined by N.J.S.A. 12:3-10 and N.J.S.A. 13:1B-13, tidelands are all lands currently and formerly flowed by the mean high tide of a natural waterway. These lands are the property of the State.

The State of New Jersey will rent and/or sell formerly flowed tidelands. However, at this time, currently flowed tidelands that have not been previously sold by the State may only be rented. The only exception is man-made waterways such as lagoons.

Licenses must be procured for the following:

1. Fixed structures (i.e. docks, piers, mooring piles, floating docks, boat lifts, riprap, etc) that are constructed or will be constructed on State-owned tidelands – **see pages 2-4**
2. Bulkhead extensions that have exceeded or will exceed the mean high water line of State-owned tidelands (These bulkhead extensions, as formerly flowed tidelands, may be purchased from the State if desired; however, they must be rented via a valid license until a riparian grant is delivered.) – **see pages 2-4**
3. Marinas (defined as five or more rented boat slips), Yacht and Boat Clubs that are constructed or will be constructed on State-owned tidelands – **see pages 4-7**
4. Dredging within State-owned tidal water – **see pages 7-9**
5. Utilities or Utility-related structures (i.e. pipes, cable lines) that cross over or under State-owned tidelands (one fee licenses) – **see pages 9-10**
6. Bridge construction/maintenance over State-owned tidelands – **see pages 10-12**
7. Modifications of existing licenses – **see pages 12-13**

Licenses must be obtained for all proposed construction as well as any past construction regardless of whether or not the current property owner is responsible for that construction. The State does not grandfather fixed structures, marinas, utilities or bridges with respect to Tidelands conveyances. All structures that are currently occupying State-owned tidelands without the benefit of a Tidelands license are considered illegal, and the State of New Jersey would be within its rights to file a lien against the adjacent upland.

Licenses are typically issued to the adjacent upland property owner. A license may be issued to an applicant who is not the adjacent upland owner provided that a recorded easement to the licensed area is obtained. For example, an easement would be needed for a dock that encroaches into the water area in front of a neighboring property.

A license typically takes between six months and one year to obtain.

The State of New Jersey is under no obligation to issue a Tidelands license. Licenses are not valid until delivered and may be revoked by the State at any time.

The State issues project-specific licenses. Each license type has particular qualifications and requirements as follows:

1. Licenses for Fixed Structures and/or 2. Licenses for Bulkhead Extensions

Fixed structures and bulkhead extensions may be licensed under a single document. Fixed structures include docks, piers, mooring piles, floating docks, boat lifts, riprap and other structures that are permanently attached over tidelands. Removable rafts and boats need not be licensed. Bulkhead extensions include any new solid material, regardless of the amount of that material, that extends the length of the upland and precludes the tide from flowing beneath it.

For residential properties, the term of this type of license is ten years unless the license is only for a bulkhead extension. In that case, the term of the license is seven years. For industrial and commercial properties, the term is seven years regardless. Before a license document expires, the property owner has the responsibility of obtaining a License Renewal Application and submitting it to the Bureau of Tidelands Management.

Requirements for Licenses for Fixed Structures and/or Bulkhead Extensions:

The materials listed in Section A are required for all applications of this project type. Some applications will have further requirements as described in Sections B and C. Please note that an application may have requirements from multiple sections.

A. All applications must include the following:

1. **License Application Form** – completed and signed by all persons listed as the current owner on the most recent recorded deed
2. **Affidavit of Title** – completed, signed by all persons listed on the current recorded deed, and notarized
3. **Recorded Deed** – a copy of the current deed as recorded in the County Clerk's office
4. **Waterfront Development Permit** – a copy of a valid waterfront development permit for all proposed or existing structures/bulkhead extensions that are to be licensed; the State of New Jersey will not issue a license until a permit copy is received; please contact the Division of Land Use Regulation at (609) 777-0454 or (609) 292-0060 for permit information
5. **Permit Application** – a copy of the completed LURP #1 permit application form for the Division of Land Use Regulation is required in the event that a waterfront development permit has not been issued for all structures/bulkhead extensions at the time the license application is submitted

6. **Property Survey** – four (4) copies of a survey; each copy must meet **all** of the following requirements:

- signed and sealed by a New Jersey Licensed Land Surveyor or a Professional Engineer; photocopies will not be accepted
- depicts the existing and proposed conditions of the property
- supplies the date of the original drawing and of any revisions; the date of either the original drawing or of the most recent revision must be current
- provides the owner's name, tax lot and block, municipality and county for the subject property
- drawn to scale in either a 1"=10', 1"=20', 1"=30', 1"=40', 1"=50' or 1"=60' scale; other scales will not be accepted
- provides the standard engineering scale used
- includes a north arrow
- depicts the complete upland of the subject property and provides appropriate bearings and distances around the entire perimeter; record title must be clearly marked
- provides the total square footage of the property; separate square footages are required for upland and liquid areas
- shows the location of the Tidelands Claim Line and notes the source of the line
- shows all existing and proposed fixed structures
- provides a License Box around all fixed structures that are to be licensed with a two-foot buffer and bearings and distances around the entire perimeter of the box
- includes a tie line between the License Box and the property sideline
- provides the total square footage of the License Box
- provides bearings and distances around any bulkhead extensions; a two-foot buffer is not required around bulkheads
- includes a tie line between bulkhead extensions and the property sideline if the extension does not commence at the sideline
- provides the total square footage of the bulkhead extension area; separate square footages must be provided for bulkhead extension areas and License Boxes
- provides the location of the current mean high water line

- shows the location of any existing tidelands conveyances (grants, licenses, Statements of No Interest, etc.) on the subject property if applicable

*Please Note: Extraneous survey details affecting the clarity of the survey may result in the need for a new survey.

- B. Applicants not applying as either private citizens or as Condominium Associations (i.e. companies, corporate entities, government agencies, counties, municipalities, etc.) must also submit the following:
 - 1. **Organization Data Form** – only a person(s) listed on this form may sign the other forms that are associated with the application (i.e. License Application Form, Affidavit of Title)
- C. When applicants are applying as a Condominium Association, the following additional requirements apply:
 - 1. The application must include a copy of the **first two pages of the Master Deed** in addition to the recorded deeds of all individual unit owners.
 - 2. All required forms must be completed in the name of the Condominium Association.

3. Marina, Yacht and Boat Club Licenses

For Tidelands purposes, a marina is a collection of docks, piers, bulkheads, mooring piles or similar structures that together provide permanent or semi-permanent dockage for rent to five or more vessels. Less than five slips would require a license for fixed structures.

Yacht and Boat Clubs are defined as non-commercial marinas with slips available only to members. Licenses for Yacht and Boat Clubs are processed in a similar fashion to commercial marinas.

The term of a marina license is seven years. Marina structures can only be combined under a single license document with other license projects that also have a seven-year term (i.e. commercial and industrial licenses for fixed structures or bulkhead extensions). In these combination cases, a marina license application must be filed. Please note, however, that the survey that accompanies a combination application must include all the requirements from all applicable license types.

Before a marina license document expires, the property owner has the responsibility of obtaining a License Renewal Application and submitting it to the Bureau of Tidelands Management.

Requirements for Marina Licenses:

The materials listed in Section A are required for all applications of this project type. Some applications will have further requirements as described in Sections B and C. Please note that an application may have requirements from multiple sections.

A. All applications must include the following:

1. **License Application Form** – completed and signed by all persons listed as the current owner on the most recent recorded deed
2. **Affidavit of Title** – completed, signed by all persons listed on the current recorded deed, and notarized
3. **Recorded Deed** – a copy of the current deed as recorded in the County Clerk's office
4. **Waterfront Development Permit** – a copy of a valid waterfront development permit for all proposed or existing marina structures that are to be licensed; the State of New Jersey will not issue a license until a permit copy is received; please contact the Division of Land Use Regulation at (609) 777-0454 or (609) 292-0060 for permit information
5. **Permit Application** – a copy of the completed LURP #1 permit application form for the Division of Land Use Regulation is required in the event that a waterfront development permit has not been issued for all marina structures at the time the license application is submitted
6. **Marina Certification Form** – completed and signed
7. **Initial Income Report** – a list of the potential annual income of each individual slip within the license area; each slip must be given a number (For Yacht and Boat Clubs, a list of all fees associated with being a club member including annual dues, slip rental fees, electric fees etc. must be submitted in lieu of potential income per slip. A list of club amenities must also be provided.)
8. **Dockage Plan** - a depiction of all slips within the license area; the slips must be numbered to correspond with the slip numbers on the Initial Income Report; this document may be hand drawn

9. **Property Survey** – four (4) copies of a survey; each copy must meet **all** of the following requirements:

- signed and sealed by a New Jersey Licensed Land Surveyor or a Professional Engineer; photocopies will not be accepted
- depicts the existing and proposed conditions of the property
- supplies the date of the original drawing and of any revisions; the date of either the original drawing or of the most recent revision must be current
- provides the owner's name, tax lot and block, municipality and county for the subject property
- drawn to scale in either a 1"=10', 1"=20', 1"=30', 1"=40', 1"=50' or 1"=60' scale; other scales will not be accepted
- provides the standard engineering scale used
- includes a north arrow
- depicts the complete upland of the subject property and provides appropriate bearings and distances around the entire perimeter; record title must be clearly marked
- provides the total square footage of the property; separate square footages are required for upland and liquid areas
- shows the location of the Tidelands Claim Line and notes the source of the line
- shows all existing and proposed marina structures
- provides a box around all marina structures with bearings and distances around the entire perimeter of the box
- includes a tie line between the box and the property sideline
- provides the location of the current mean high water line
- shows the location of any existing tidelands conveyances (grants, licenses, Statements of No Interest, etc.) on the subject property if applicable

*Please Note: Extraneous survey details affecting the clarity of the survey may result in the need for a new survey.

B. Applicants not applying as either private citizens or as Condominium Associations (i.e. companies, corporate entities, government agencies, counties, municipalities, etc.) must also submit the following:

1. **Organization Data Form** – only a person(s) listed on this form may sign the other forms that are associated with the application (i.e. License Application Form, Affidavit of Title)
- C. When applicants are applying as a Condominium Association, the following additional requirements apply:
1. The application must include a copy of the **first two pages of the Master Deed** in addition to the recorded deeds of all individual unit owners.
 2. All required forms must be completed in the name of the Condominium Association.

4. Dredging Licenses

Dredging projects cannot be combined with non-dredging projects under a single license document; they require separate applications. The term of a dredging license is generally one year. A dredging license cannot be renewed. If the term of the license expires prior to commencement of the project, a new application must be submitted.

Requirements for Dredging Licenses:

The materials listed in Section A are required for all applications of this project type. Some applications will have further requirements as described in Sections B and C. Please note that an application may have requirements from multiple sections.

- A. All applications must include the following:
1. **License Application Form** – completed and signed by all persons listed as the current owner on the most recent recorded deed
 2. **Waterfront Development Permit** – a copy of a valid waterfront development permit is required for every dredging license application; the State of New Jersey will not issue a license until a permit copy is received; please contact the Division of Land Use Regulation at (609) 777-0454 or (609) 292-0060 for permit information
 3. **Permit Application** – a copy of the completed LURP #1 permit application form for the Division of Land Use Regulation is required in the event that a waterfront development permit has not been issued for the dredging project at the time the license application is submitted
 4. **Easement to the Licensed Area** – if the applicant is not the owner of all of the upland adjacent to the dredging project, a recorded easement that is guaranteed to extend through the expiration of the license agreement is

required for the proposed license area; if the applicant is the sole adjacent upland owner, a copy of the recorded deed and a completed Affidavit of Title Form are required; if the applicant owns some of the adjacent upland but not all of it, the easement is required in addition to a copy of the recorded deed and an Affidavit of Title Form

5. **Property Survey** – four (4) copies of a survey; each copy must meet **all** of the following requirements:

- signed and sealed by a New Jersey Licensed Land Surveyor or a Professional Engineer; photocopies will not be accepted
- supplies the date of the original drawing and of any revisions; the date of either the original drawing or of the most recent revision must be current
- provides the applicant's name, municipality and county for the project
- drawn to scale in either a 1"=10', 1"=20', 1"=30', 1"=40', 1"=50' or 1"=60' scale; other scales will not be accepted
- provides the standard engineering scale used
- includes a north arrow
- shows the location of the Tidelands Claim Line and notes the source of the line
- provides a general outline of the area to be dredged
- provides the volume of the dredge area in cubic yards
- shows the location of any existing tidelands conveyances (grants, licenses, Statements of No Interest, etc.) that intersect the dredging project if applicable

*Please Note: Extraneous survey details affecting the clarity of the survey may result in the need for a new survey.

B. Applicants not applying as either private citizens or as Condominium Associations (i.e. companies, corporate entities, government agencies, counties, municipalities, etc.) must also submit the following:

1. **Organization Data Form** – only a person(s) listed on this form may sign the other forms that are associated with the application (i.e. License Application Form, Affidavit of Title)

C. When applicants are applying as a Condominium Association, the following additional requirements apply:

1. The application must include a copy of the **first two pages of the Master Deed** in addition to the recorded deeds of all individual unit owners.
2. All required forms must be completed in the name of the Condominium Association.

5. Utility or Utility-related (One Fee) Licenses

Licenses for permanent utilities or utility-related structures (i.e. pipes, cable lines, storm water outfalls, etc) that cross over or under State-owned tidelands are referred to as **one fee licenses**.

A one fee license may only be obtained by entities that are able to operate and maintain the utility now and forever (i.e. counties, municipalities, utility companies).

A one fee license does not have a term and does not require renewal; it is a perpetual license unless the utility or utility-related structure is abandoned or removed for reasons of public safety.

Requirements for One Fee Licenses:

A. All applications must include the following:

1. **License Application Form** – completed and signed
2. **Waterfront Development Permit** – a copy of a valid waterfront development permit is required for every one fee license application; the State of New Jersey will not issue a license until a permit copy is received; please contact the Division of Land Use Regulation at (609) 777-0454 or (609) 292-0060 for permit information
3. **Permit Application** – a copy of the completed LURP #1 permit application form for the Division of Land Use Regulation is required in the event that a waterfront development permit has not been issued for the one fee project at the time the license application is submitted
4. **Easement for the Affected Upland Area** – if the applicant is not the owner of all of the upland affected by the one fee project, a recorded and permanent easement to all of the affected upland is required up to the proposed license area; if the applicant is the sole owner of the affected property, a copy of the recorded deed and a completed Affidavit of Title Form are required; if the applicant owns some of the affected upland but not all of it, the easement is required in addition to a copy of the recorded deed and an Affidavit of Title Form

5. Written Description of the Project

6. **Organization Data Form** – only a person(s) listed on this form may sign the other forms that are associated with the application (i.e. License Application Form, Affidavit of Title)
7. **Property Survey** – four (4) copies of a survey; each copy must meet **all** of the following requirements:
 - signed and sealed by a New Jersey Licensed Land Surveyor or a Professional Engineer; photocopies will not be accepted
 - supplies the date of the original drawing and of any revisions; the date of either the original drawing or of the most recent revision must be current
 - provides the applicant's name, municipality and county for the project
 - drawn to scale in either a 1"=10', 1"=20', 1"=30', 1"=40', 1"=50' or 1"=60' scale; other scales will not be accepted
 - provides the standard engineering scale used
 - includes a north arrow
 - shows the location of the Tidelands Claim Line and notes the source of the line
 - visually depicts the scope and location of the proposed project
 - provides the length of the proposed project in linear feet (or square feet for non-linear projects such as outfalls)
 - provides the location of the current mean high water line
 - shows the location of any existing tidelands conveyances (grants, licenses, Statements of No Interest, etc.) that intersect the one fee project if applicable

*Please Note: Extraneous survey details affecting the clarity of the survey may result in the need for a new survey.

6. Bridge Licenses

Only certain bridge construction/maintenance projects occurring over State-owned tidelands require Tidelands licenses. For information on the license applicability for a specific bridge project, please contact the Bureau of Tidelands Management.

The term of a bridge license is seven years.

Requirements for Bridge Licenses:

A. All applications must include the following:

1. **License Application Form** – completed and signed
2. **Waterfront Development Permit** – a copy of a valid waterfront development permit is required for every bridge license application; the State of New Jersey will not issue a license until a permit copy is received; please contact the Division of Land Use Regulation at (609) 777-0454 or (609) 292-0060 for permit information
3. **Permit Application** – a copy of the completed LURP #1 permit application form for the Division of Land Use Regulation is required in the event that a waterfront development permit has not been issued for the bridge project at the time the license application is submitted
4. **Organization Data Form** – only a person(s) listed on this form may sign the other forms that are associated with the application (i.e. License Application Form, Affidavit of Title)
5. **Property Survey** – four (4) copies of a survey; each copy must meet **all** of the following requirements:
 - signed and sealed by a New Jersey Licensed Land Surveyor or a Professional Engineer; photocopies will not be accepted
 - supplies the date of the original drawing and of any revisions; the date of either the original drawing or of the most recent revision must be current
 - provides the applicant's name, municipality and county for the project
 - drawn to scale in either a 1"=10', 1"=20', 1"=30', 1"=40', 1"=50' or 1"=60' scale; other scales will not be accepted
 - provides the standard engineering scale used
 - includes a north arrow
 - depicts the existing and proposed conditions of the applicable right of way
 - shows the location of the Tidelands Claim Line and notes the source of the line
 - depicts the entire existing and/or proposed bridge
 - depicts any areas of temporary occupation of State-owned tidelands in the vicinity of the bridge that will be due to bridge construction or maintenance

- provides the square footage of the existing and/or proposed bridge
- provides the square footage of all areas of temporary occupation in the vicinity of the bridge that will be due to bridge construction or maintenance
- provides the location of the current mean high water line on both sides of the bridge
- shows the location of any existing tidelands conveyances (grants, licenses, Statements of No Interest, etc.) that intersect the bridge project if applicable

*Please Note: Extraneous survey details affecting the clarity of the survey may result in the need for a new survey.

7. Modifications of Existing Licenses

Only licenses for fixed structures, bulkhead extensions, marinas and bridges can be modified.

For licenses for fixed structures, bulkhead extensions and bridges, license modifications are **required** for any construction that has occurred or will occur outside of the existing license area. All structures or portions of structures that are built over State-owned tidelands outside of an approved license or other conveyance are illegal; the State of New Jersey has the right to file a lien against the adjacent upland even if the property benefits from an existing conveyance. Modifications may also be obtained for licenses for fixed structures, bulkhead extensions and bridges to reduce an existing license area if desired and if applicable.

For licenses for marinas, modifications are **required** if slips have been added or removed.

Requirements for Modifications of Existing Licenses:

The materials listed in Section A are required for all applications of this project type. Some applications will have further requirements as described in Sections B and C. Please note that an application may have requirements from multiple sections.

A. All applications must include the following:

1. **License Application Form** – completed and signed by all persons listed as the current owner on the most recent recorded deed
2. **Waterfront Development Permit** – a copy of a valid waterfront development permit for all proposed or existing structures/bulkhead extensions that are to be licensed; the State of New Jersey will not issue a

license until a permit copy is received; please contact the Division of Land Use Regulation at (609) 777-0454 or (609) 292-0060 for permit information

3. **Permit Application** – a copy of the completed LURP #1 permit application form for the Division of Land Use Regulation is required in the event that a waterfront development permit has not been issued for all structures/bulkhead extensions at the time the license application is submitted
4. **Property Survey** – the survey requirements for a modification are the same as the survey requirements for the initial application

B. Applicants not applying as either private citizens or as Condominium Associations (i.e. companies, corporate entities, government agencies, counties, municipalities, etc.) must also submit the following:

1. **Organization Data Form** – only a person(s) listed on this form may sign the other forms that are associated with the application (i.e. License Application Form, Affidavit of Title)

C. If ownership of the property has changed since the issuance of the existing license, the following items are also required:

1. **Affidavit of Title** – completed, signed by all persons listed on the current recorded deed, and notarized
2. **Recorded Deed** – a copy of the current deed as recorded in the County Clerk's office
