Remediation Sites

Camden Coke Plant

(Cooperating Party)

1986 - Filed in DEP (ECRA/ISRA Trigger).
 1987 - ACO Genstar Gypsum (PSE&G takes over).
 2003 - Remedial Action Work Plan Proposal Submitted - Insufficient in relation to river sediments.
 April 2005 - PSE&G agrees to prepare solutions to address impacts to the river.
 May 2005 - Initial meeting of DEP/PSE&G cooperative effort.

DuPont Chambers Works

(Cooperating Party)

1984 - Filed in DEP.
 1988 - Under partial site ACO, HSWA permit and NJPDES-DGW permit, began remedial investigations, cleanup of 17 solid waste management units, interim measures, pump and treat.
 April 2005 - DEP requests workplan for site-wide characterization and remediation in 90 days. DuPont reprioritizes per DEP request.
 July 2005 - Workplan Due.

Lail Property Site (ExxonMobil)

1993 - Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with ExxonMobil.
 November 2000 - Amended MOA to address Anomaly J PCB Area.
 May 2003 - ExxonMobil proposed sheet pile wall IRM. DEP determines insufficient.
 February 2005 - Revised IRM and RI Workplan. DEP determines insufficient.
 April 2005 - DEP terminates MOA, issues Spill Act Directive with draft ACO to do IRM and Remediation.
 May 15, 2005 - Reply Due from ExxonMobil, ACO to be signed.
 June 15, 2005 - Due date to implement IRM.

Matlack Inc

1990 - Filed in DEP.
 1990 - 2000 - Oversight in Bureau of Case Management.
 2001 - Company files Ch 11 Bankruptcy, ceased operations.
 November 2001 - DEP pulls \$2 Million remediation funding source (letter of credit).
 2002-2004 - DEP negotiates with at least three potential purchasers.
 April 2005 - DEP initiates cleanup with the responsible party's funds. Begins delineation of ground water contamination, evaluation of pump and treat system.
 May 2005 - DEP to begin surface water and sediment sampling, and will confirm 2002 sampling indicating no potable wells impacted.

Matteo Iron & Metal

1992 - Filed in DEP
 1995,1999,2002 - Pay Directives to carry out remediation. DEP preserves right to Treble Damages.
 March 22, 2005 - Site visit to evaluate options for removal of contaminated material.
 2005 - DEP continues with remediation selection and design.

Sunoco Eagle Point

(Cooperating Party)

1984: Site filed in DEP (ECRA/ISRA trigger).
 January 2004: New owner (Sunoco) signs Remediation Agreement, voluntarily reprioritizes remediation at the site.
 April 2005 - DEP prioritizes three major environmental issues related to surface water: free product impacts to river, impacts to wetlands, off-site migration.
 May 2005 - Workplan due to address these issues.

Landfill Sites

DuPont Repauno Landfill

1971 - Landfill registered with DEP.
 1989 - Landfill ceased operations; Administrative Consent Order executed for remediation.
 1994 - 1998 - Ground water monitoring.
 2004 - Landfill Closure Construction Completed.
 June 2005 - Closure Certification Revisions Due.
 July 2005 - Approval of Construction/Closure by DEP.

Pennsauken Landfill

1971 - Landfill Registered with DEP.
 1982 - Cell A Ceased Operations.
 1988 - Administrative Consent Order.
 Approx. 1995 - 2005 - In Litigation (RP with PRPs) to fund and install Ground Water Remediation Pump and Treat System.
 November 2004 - Landfill Closure (Cap) Construction Completed.
 June 2005 - Approval (by DEP) of Cap Portion of Closure Construction.
 August 2005 - Remedial Action Workplan (including groundwater remediation) anticipated submission date.
 December 2005 - DEP to determine adequacy of ground water Remedial Action Workplan

Pennsville Township Sanitary Landfill

1971 - Landfill registered with DEP.
 April 1988 - Ceased Operations.
 January 2005 - Closure Plan Approved - includes ground water monitoring.
 January 2006 - Closure Construction Due.

Salem City Landfill

1971 - Landfill registered with DEP.
 1986 - Landfill ceased Operations.
 January 1996 - Closure Plan Approval - included ground water monitoring.
 July 2005 - Closure Construction Due Date.
