SCHEDULING ORDER

(INTERVENTION MOTIONS)

The Court has been advised that third parties may file motions to intervene in this matter and has determined, in the interest of judicial economy, to set a deadline for such motions so that the statutorily mandated approval process of the proposed settlement between the parties may be timely considered.

It is ORDERED on this 9th day of JUNE, 2015 that:

1. Persons or entities desiring to file intervention motions shall file such motions in accordance with the New Jersey Court Rules with the Clerk of the Superior Court in Union County no later than the close of business on **June 25, 2015**.


Simultaneously, copies of such motions shall be:

- a. hand-delivered to the chambers of Michael J. Hogan, P.J. Ch. (Retired and on Recall), at 49 Rancocas Rd. Mount Holly, New Jersey, 08060; and
- b. delivered via electronic mail directly to the parties in this matter as follows to:

The Court will not consider intervention motions filed after **June 25, 2015**.

2. The State's and Exxon's responses to such motions shall be filed with the Court on or before **July 6, 2015**. There will be no replies unless otherwise directed by the court.
3. Oral argument on the motion(s) will be at **9:00 AM July 10, 2015**.
4. The Court has previously directed the parties to submit the application to approve the settlement no later than **July 9, 2015**. That direction remains unchanged. In the event the intervention motions are denied, oral argument on the proposed settlement will be held on **July 21, 2015**. In the event that the intervention motions are granted, oral argument will be rescheduled as needed.
