

SUBJECT

George Bunis, Chlorinated Products Division, Newark, phoned me Friday afternoon. He said in their hydrolysis of 1,2,4-trichlorobenzene, the pressure never exceeded 210 psi. I don't know the temperature. The charge may have contained too much H₂O and not enough CH₃OH. He welcomed the idea of Charlie coming to Newark to assist in making the next runs. I told him you would call him to arrange for Charlie Entemann to go to Newark. He is ordering more 1,2,4-trichlorobenzene. The two drums of product were shipped "on schedule."

I asked about running the second steam distillation and he will have an answer when you call him.
