The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) is readopting without amendments the Dam Restoration and Inland Waters Projects Loan Program rules at N.J.A.C. 7:24A. The rules govern loans to assist local government units, private lake associations or similar organizations, and owners of private dams for dam restoration and inland waters projects pursuant to the Green Acres, Clean Water, Farmland and Historic Preservation Bond Act of 1992, P.L. 1992 c. 88 and the Dam, Lake, Stream, Flood Control, Water Resources and Wastewater Treatment Project Bond Act of 2003, P.L. 2003 c.162. The proposal of the readoption without amendments was published in the New Jersey Register at 42 N.J.R. 2177(a) on September 20, 2010. The comment period closed on November 19, 2010.
