

Change log for Preliminary Assessment Technical Guidance Version 1.1 to 1.2

1. Document date: Changed from April, 2013 to September 2015.
2. Document version: Changed from version 1.1 to version 1.2.
3. Section 1, page 4: Updated third paragraph to reflect SRP's policy regarding a 6-month phase-in period for using new/revised technical guidance.
4. Section 1, page 4: Alphabetized the list of committee members.
5. Section 1, page 4: Updated companies of employment for the committee members who are LSRPs and added the word "retired" to indicate the status of a NJDEP committee Member.
6. Section 2.2.1, Page 6: Replaced the word "later" with the word "earlier" in order to correct the tense to indicate the original intent of the sentence.
7. Section 2.3.1, Page 7: Replaced the word "later" with the word "earlier" in order to correct the tense to indicate the original intent of the sentence.
8. Section 2.7.1, Page 10, 1st paragraph: An additional sentence was added at the end of this paragraph stating "Starting in 1986 under the Right to Know laws facilities were required to file forms with the DEP Office of Pollution Prevention and Right to Know. The forms detail the types and quantities of hazardous materials used on site. The Investigator should request a copy of these records through an OPRA (Open Public Records Act) request." This sentence was added in order to provide guidance regarding an additional resource the investigator can use to gather information about the site.
9. Section 2.10.1, Page 13, 2nd paragraph: Deleted second sentence as the statement could be interpreted incorrectly to mean that DEP oversight is only required when radionuclide contamination exists at the AOC/Site.
10. Section 2.14.1, Page 17, 2nd paragraph: Removed "and Diffuse Anthropogenic Pollutants" from the referenced document title as the title of the document was changed to remove this language. Document is now entitled "Historic Fill Technical Guidance."
11. Section 2.16.2, Page 19, 1st Paragraph 1st Sentence: Added the word "of" to make the sentence grammatically correct.
12. Section 2.18.2, Page 20: 1st Paragraph, Section i.(3) – Added an "n" to "a" before the word "alternative" in order to make the sentence grammatically correct.
13. Section 2.19.1, Page 23: D) Discharge and Disposal Areas, 1st & 2nd Bullets – Added the names of the referenced regulations for additional clarity.

14. Section 2.19.1, Page 23: E) Building Interior Areas with a Potential for Discharge to the Environment, 5th Bullet – Removed the period at the end of the line to make the format consistent.
15. Section 3.1, Page 28: last sentence in section – Changed format to justify left in order to make the sentence easier to read. Added a colon prior to the hyper link and replaced the semicolon at the end of the hyperlink with a period in order to make the sentence grammatically correct.
