		The agreement must be signed by both parties.	
		The agreement should include the following for each party, as applicable, of the interconnections:   reason for use (i.e. emergency, bulk sale, bulk purchase),  size,  hydraulic capacity, in each direction,  proposed flow rate,  whether the interconnection is one-way or two-way,  whether or not pumping is required for interconnection use,  notification process/timing required prior to use,  location (street address),  who owns and maintains the interconnection,  any duration constraints,  whether metered and if not, how volumes transferred is determined	
		The agreement must list the date signed and the date through which the agreement is valid, or whether it contains a rolling renewal.	
		The agreement must include rates in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:19-6.9(e) & (f).	
		The agreement must include a schedule for the annual interconnection flow test in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:19-6.9(d) for systems >10,000 population.
