

**Dear Stakeholder,**

On May 3, 2019, Governor Murphy signed into law an Act concerning public access to certain public trust lands (PL. 2019 c. 81), which codifies the public's rights under the Public Trust Doctrine to use and enjoy the State's tidal waters and adjacent shorelines. Accordingly, Land Use Management will be undertaking rulemaking to amend the Coastal Zone Management and Flood Hazard Area Control Act Rules to implement this law and will include an examination of all permits-by-rule, general permits-by-certification, and general permits.
