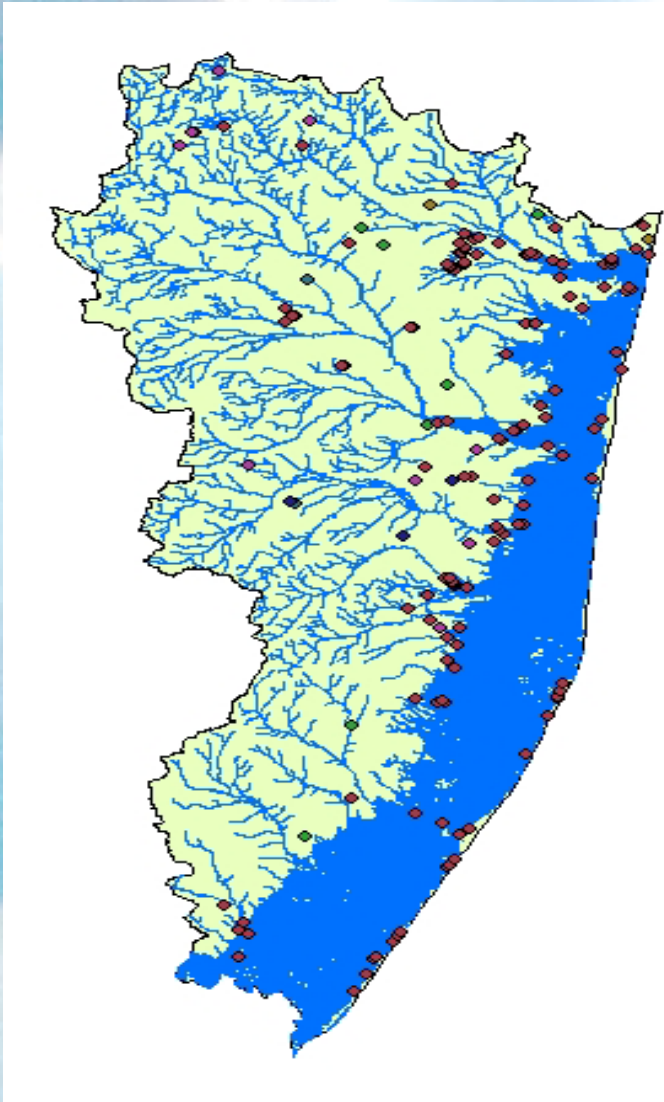

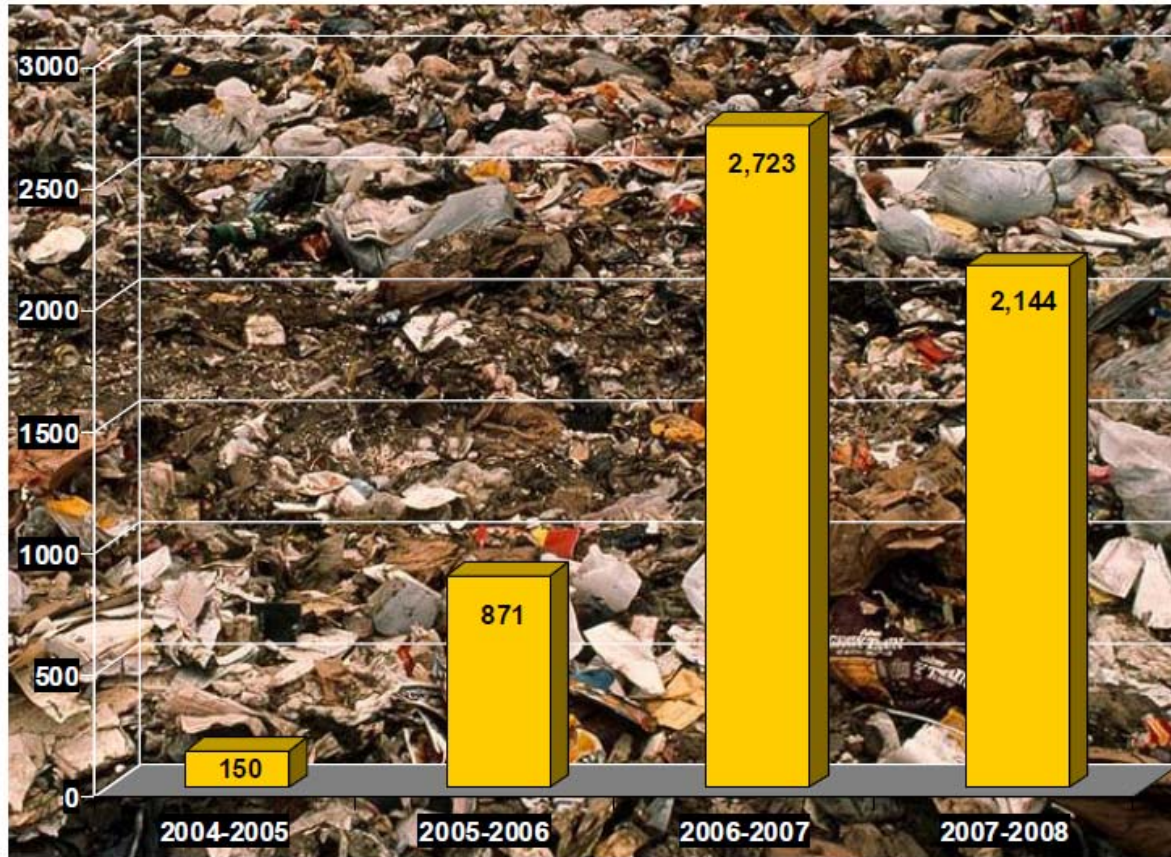

Pollutant	Raw Wash Water*	Surface Water Quality Criteria (SE1) (acute / chronic)
Copper	8,890 ug/L	4.8 / 3.1 ug/L
Lead	60 ug/L	210 / 24 ug/L
Zinc	1,110 ug/L	90 / 81 ug/L
