REVISION TO THE LOWER DELAWARE WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

MAY 23 1995 TAKE NOTICE that on , pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seg., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Lower Delaware Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department. This revision identifies a 50,000 gallon per day (gpd) wastewater discharge to ground water which serves the Fairview Manor Mobile Home Park. The property is located at 2110 Mays Landing Road, in the City of Vineland, Cumberland County, and is identified as Lot 5.01, Block 1130 on the City of Vineland tax maps. The site consists of 65.57 acres. Fairview Manor Mobile Home Park received an approval from the New Jersey State Department of Environmental Protection on July 19, 1973 for the 50,000 gpd discharge to ground water, however, this facility was inadvertently never previously identified within the Lower Delaware WQMP.
