The amendment, identified as Galetto SSA (Program Interest No. 435441, Activity No. AMD190002), expanded the sewer service area (SSA) of the Landis Sewerage Authority by 13 acres on Block 302, Lot 2, Vineland City, Cumberland County.

A notice of the adoption of this amendment was published in the New Jersey Register on November 2, 2020, at 52 N.J.R. 2013(d). Upon publication of the adoption notice, it was recognized there was a typographical error regarding the parcel information.
