REVISION TO THE LOWER RARTIAN/MIDDLESEX COUNTY AND NORTHEAST WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLANS

TAKE NOTICE that on January 11, 2006 , pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seg, and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Lower Raritan/Middlesex County Water Quality Management Plan and the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision also modifies the Lower Raritan/Middlesex County Wastewater Management Plan. This revision provides for the transfer of sewer service area and flows from the Rahway Valley Sewerage Authority to the Middlesex County Utilities Authority. Rolling Hills Estates is located on Block 15303, Lots 2.01, 2.02, 3.01, 6.02 & 7.02 in Scotch Plains Township. The property consists of 7.5 acres and has been subdivided to construct five homes with two homes previously existing. The wastewater generated by the five new Rolling Hills Estates homes are to be transferred from Rahway Valley Sewerage Authority to the Middlesex County Utilities Authority will total 1,500 gpd. The two existing homes are already in the Middlesex County Utilities Authority sewer service area. The Rolling Hills Estates project qualifies as a revision under N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5(b)4ii.
