REVISION TO THE MERCER COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on **NOV 1 4 2000**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq, and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Mercer County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision corrects the Washington Township Wastewater Management Plan to include Block 13 lots 5 and 6 into the sewer service area. The projected flow of Block 13 Lots 5 and 6 is estimated at 1020 gpd and the inclusion of lots 5 and 6 will increase the sewer service area by 8.59 acres. This additional flow will not cause a treatment plant expansion.

Also included into this revision are lots 1,2,3, 4, 7,8,9,28,29,31 of Block 13. Most of these small lots are already sewered and appear in the sewer service area on Washington Township's map. This revision appears on Map#3 Future Wastewater treatment Facilities and Service Areas prepared by Van Cleef Engineering revised June 8, 2000.

This revision will correct the Washington Township Wastewater Management Plan to be consistent with the Township's July 1987 map entitled "Water Quality

Management Plan: Mercer County, New Jersey"
