

REVISION TO THE NORTHEAST WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on January 11, 2006 pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department. The revision modifies the Parsippany-Troy Hills Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) to address the Pfizer Incorporated facility, located in Parsippany Township, Morris County, which is classified as a minor discharger permitted under New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NJPDES) permit number NJ0003450. This existing facility manufactures proprietary drugs, cosmetics and health care products. This facility has an estimated combined long term average flow of 0.4109 million gallons per day (mgd). This facility discharges via outfall DSN0001A to an unnamed tributary to Eastman's Brook, which is classified as FW2-NT. The wastewater consists of approximately 62 percent non-contact cooling water from mixing vessels and air handlers, 14 percent non-industrial stormwater and 24 percent reverse osmosis concentrate and rinse water from water purification and filtration. Sanitary and pretreated process wastewater is discharged to the Parsippany-Troy Hills Sewerage Authority, which is regulated under NJPDES permit number NJ0103713. This revision is being adopted in accordance with N.J.A.C.7:15-3.5(b)1(i), which allows the Department to make corrections regarding existing facility's information, which existed at the time of the most recently adopted areawide WQMP or amendment affecting the site.
