REVISION TO THE NORTHEAST WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on JUL 30, 2008, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq, and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision updates the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan and the Rockaway Valley Regional Sewerage Authority Wastewater Management Plan to identify the existing Greenpond Inn discharge to ground water located on Block 40801, Lot 83 in Rockaway Township, Morris County, New Jersey. The facility, with permit number NJG0160547, has an estimated daily flow of 3,960 gallons per day that serves a 60 seat bar and restaurant, a service station, one 4-bedroom dwelling, three 1-bedroom dwellings, and two 2-bedroom dwellings. The facility will continue under this same permit, but will serve a modified development (referred to as Green Pond Mews) consisting of eleven town homes, which will replace the current development as described above. The wastewater flow will be reduced to 3,850 gallons per day.

This revision has been reviewed in accordance with Executive Order No. 109 (2000) and N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.18. Due to the scope of this revision, it is not subject to the alternative analysis under that Executive Order and rule provision. This revision modifies the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan.
