
AMENDMENT TO THE SUSSEX COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT
PLAN

Public Notice

Take notice that on **MAR 2 1998**, pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Sussex County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department of Environmental Protection.

This amendment allows the project owner, the Sussex and Warren Holding Corporation, to relocate the proposed Life Care Mews, 65,200 gallons per day, discharge to ground water wastewater treatment facility from its previously approved location in Andover Township, Sussex County (Lot 1.01, Block 108) as delineated in the Andover Township Wastewater Management Plan, to Lot 5, Block 108. The area serviced by this facility remains unchanged and consists of Block 108; Lots 1.01, 1.02, 1.03, 1.04, 1.05, & 2, totaling 67.1 acres. The proposed wastewater treatment facility and infiltration percolation discharge lagoon will be located within Lot 5, Block 108 comprising 15.52 acres.

This amendment represents only one part of the permit process and other issues will be addressed prior to final permit issuance. Additional issues which were not reviewed in conjunction with this amendment but which may need to be addressed may include, but are not limited to, the following: antidegradation; effluent limitations; water quality analysis; exact locations and designs of future treatment works (pump stations, interceptors, sewers, outfalls, wastewater treatment plants); and development in wetlands, flood prone areas, designated Wild and Scenic River areas, or other environmentally sensitive areas which are subject to regulation under Federal or State statutes or rules.
