

REVISION TO THE SUSSEX COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on **FEB 17 1999**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Sussex County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision updates the Montague Township Wastewater Management Plan to allow the New Jersey Department of Corrections to provide a permanent holding tank (minimum capacity of 40,000 gallons, approximate three-day storage capacity) for the wastewater generated at their Mountainview Stokes Correctional Facility (previously known as the Annandale-Stokes Forest Unit) in Montague Township, Sussex County. All surface or groundwater discharges from the Mountainview Stokes Correctional Facility will be abandoned and instead the generated wastewater will be trucked to the facilities of the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority or a comparable facility on a permanent basis.
