Re: Tri-County Water Quality Management Plan Amendment

A plan amendment was submitted for approval and adoption by the Department of Environmental Protection. This amendment approved the Mount Laurel Township Municipal Utilities Authority Wastewater Management Plan (WMP). The WMP allows the expansion of the existing Hartford Road Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) from 2.95 MGD to 6.0 MGD. The WMP also calls for the abandonment of the existing Rancocas Woods, Ramblewood, and New Jersey Turnpike Service Area treatment facilities. The wastewater currently treated at these facilities will be conveyed to the Hartford Road STP for treatment. The WMP will also expand the sewer service area in Mount Laurel Township.

This amendment was given preliminary approval on December 10, 1987, and was noticed in the N.J. Register on January 19, 1988. Since we have received no significant comments on this amendment during the 30 day comment period, I am pleased to inform you that pursuant to the N.J. Water Quality Planning Act (N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq.), and the Water Quality Management Planning and Implementation Process Regulations (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4 et seq.), this amendment is now formally approved and adopted as of the date of this letter. Final notice of this adoption will be placed in the New Jersey Register.
