AMENDMENT TO THE TRI-COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Take notice that on May 2, 1988 pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the "Water Quality Management Planning and Implementation Process" Regulations (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Tri-County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This amendment approves the Delran Township Wastewater Management Plan (WMP). This WMP will allow the expansion of the existing Delran Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) from 1.5 million gallons per day (MGD) to 2.5 MGD. The WMP will also expand the sewer service area of the Township.
