Take notice that on May 5, 1988 pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the "Water Quality Management Planning and Implementation Process" Regulations (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Tri-County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This amendment is to adopt the Borough of Palmyra's Wastewater Management Plan (WMP). The Borough of Palmyra WMP addresses the expansion of the existing Palmyra Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) from 0.53 million gallons per day (mgd) to 1.05 mgd and the expansion of the sewer service area in the Borough.
