This amendment expands the sewer service are of the Evesham Municipal Utilities Authority to include Block 3201, Lot 1 in Medford Township, Burlington County. This lot was located in an area identified as suitable for individual subsurface sewage disposal systems, according to the Medford Township Wastewater Management Plan, but site conditions (i.e.: the presence of freshwater wetlands) precluded the use of such systems.
