Take notice that on , pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Tri-County Water Quality Management (WQM) Plan was adopted by the Department. This amendment expands the sewer service area of the Harrison Township sewage treatment plant approximately 9.5 acres to include various lots in Block 49, Harrison Township, Gloucester County. This sewer service area expansion will serve the proposed Cider Press Estates Phase II development. The proposed wastewater flow from these residential lots is 4,800 gallons per day.
