REVISION TO THE TRI-COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on **SEP 10 1999**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Tri-County Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department. This revision was requested on behalf of Sancoa International, an existing manufacturing facility located on Block 36, Lot 13.03 in Lumberton Township, Burlington County. The revision modifies the Mount Holly Municipal Utilities Authority (MHMUA) Wastewater Management Plan with regard to this site. The facility is within the future sewer service area of the MHMUA, however conveyance facilities have not yet been extended to this area. The revision would allow expansion of the existing discharge to ground water to a total of 11,468 gallons per day with the provision that, when infrastructure to convey wastewater to the MHMUA Sewage Treatment Plant is available, the discharge to ground water will be abandoned and the connection made to the MHMUA facilities.
