
REVISION TO THE TRI-COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT
PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on *12/6/04*, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Tri-County Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department. This proposal revises the service area for the Beverly Sewerage Authority sewage treatment plant (STP) within Delanco Township, Burlington County. This revision includes the addition of the parcel generally known as the Pennington Farm, to facilitate the construction of the Delanco Township Pennington Farm Athletic Complex and allow for improvements to the adjoining Burlington County Park System's Pennington Park.


This revision of the Tri-County WQMP will add an additional 99.3 acres to the sewer service area (SSA) of Beverly Sewerage Authority's STP on Block 2100; Lots 12 & 13, Block 2200; Lots 1 & 2 in Delanco Township. The revised service area is depicted on a digitally prepared map entitled "TOWNSHIP OF DELANCO BURLINGTON COUNTY, NEW JERSEY WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN FUTURE WASTEWATER FACILITIES AND SERVICE AREAS – MAP No. 3", prepared by Birdsell Engineering Inc., dated April 13, 2004, unrevised.

This revision is for the construction of the Pennington Farm Athletic Complex and improvements to Pennington Park. It is anticipated that these

improvements and new facilities will contribute a maximum of an additional 3,000 gallons per day (GPD) of flow to the Beverly Sewerage Authority STP. This expansion of the SSA is to contiguous lots, less than 100 acres in size, contributing less than 8,000 gallons per day of additional wastewater flow and does not create a significantly new pattern of sewer development.
