AMENDMENT TO THE UPPER DELAWARE WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Public Notice

Take notice that on MAR 2 2 1995, pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Upper Delaware Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department of Environmental Protection (Department). This amendment, submitted by Greenwich Township in Warren County, identifies the Koh-I-Noor Rapidograph, Inc. (Lot 11.02, Block 31) and Cross Jersey Executive Park (Lot 11, Block 31) on-site ground water disposal facilities as interim facilities. The Southerly Region sewage treatment plant (STP) sewer service area is expanded to include these two properties. Upon construction of the Southerly Region STP these on-site facilities will be abandoned and the flows diverted to the Southerly Region STP.

This amendment represents only one part of the permit process and other issues will be addressed prior to final permit issuance. Additional issues which were not reviewed in conjunction with this amendment but which may need to be addressed may include, but are not limited to, the following: antidegradation; effluent limitations; water quality analysis; exact locations and designs of future treatment works (pump stations, interceptors, sewers, outfalls, wastewater treatment plants); and development in wetlands, flood prone areas, designated Wild and Scenic River areas, or other environmentally sensitive areas which are subject to regulation under Federal or State statutes or rules.
