Adopted Amendment to the Upper Delaware Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP)

Take notice that on NOV = 7 2014, pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Upper Delaware WQMP was adopted by the Department of Environmental Protection (Department). This amendment, submitted on behalf of Mr. Pio Mannino, of Trinacria, LLC, as the property owner, expands the sewer service area (SSA) of the Warren County Pequest Municipal Utilities Authority (MUA) Belvidere Wastewater Treatment Facility (WTF) to include the La Torre Plaza Commercial Development located on Block 21, Lot 7.03 in White Township, Warren County. The Warren County Pequest MUA Belvidere WTF discharges to the Delaware River under NJDPES permit number NJ0035114.

This amendment proposal was noticed in the New Jersey Bulletin on August 20, 2014 at 38, 16 and no comments were received during the comment period.

This amendment represents only one part of the permit process and other issues may need to be addressed prior to final permit issuance. Additional issues which may need to be addressed may include, but are not limited to, the following: compliance with stormwater regulations; antidegradation; effluent limitations; water quality analysis; exact locations and designs of future treatment works (pump stations, interceptors, sewers, outfalls, wastewater treatment plants); and development in wetlands, flood prone areas, designated Wild and Scenic River areas, or other environmentally sensitive areas which are subject to regulation under Federal or State statutes or rules.
