REVISION TO THE UPPER RARITAN WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on JAN 2 5 2001 , pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 <u>et seq,</u> and the Statewide Water Quality 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Upper Raritan Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision, submitted by the Washington Township Municipal Utilities Authority, provides an updated Wastewater Management Plan for Washington Township, Morris County. The revision makes minor redefinition to the Long Valley and Schooley's Mountain Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) sewer service areas. The WMP has been updated to reflect the construction of the Long Valley STP and subsequent abandonment of four treatment plants. The revision also allows for the inclusion of non-process wastewater flows from the Welsh Farms complex into the Long Valley STP. The Schooley's Mountain service area has been corrected to identify lots which are receiving service but which were not previously identified as within the sewer service area and the addition of a few small lots in conformance with the Township Master Plan. No expansion of any STP is proposed to accommodate the additional lots.

The lots to be included in the Schooley's Mountain STP sewer service area include: Block 12.02, Lots 10 and 12; Block 13, Lot 12.03; Block 20, Lot 90; Block 20.10, Lot 45; Block 22, Lots 2.02 and 2.03; Block 23, Lots 8, 8.03, 8.04, 8.05, 8.06 and 8.07; Block 23, Lots 16.02, 16.03, 16.04, and 16.06; Block 23.01, Lot 13; and Block 25, Lots 55, 56.02 and 57. Lots to be removed from the Schooley's Mountain sewer service area include: Block 20.10, Lot 47 and Block 23, Lot 16.01.

The lots to be included in the Long Valley STP sewer service area include: Block 28, Lot and 47; Block 35, Lot 6.01; and Block 37, Lots 34.01, 34.02, 34.04, 34.06 and

35. Lots to be removed from the Long Valley sewer service area include: Block 26, Lot 50; and Block 35, Lot 20.
