

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 17 day of March, 2015, entered in the amount of \$8,504.00 against Defendant Shaneece Rivers and in favor of the Plaintiff, Kenneth E. Kobylowski,

Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$5,000.00 in civil penalties pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b for one (1) violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 et seq.; attorneys' fees of \$2,504.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant Shaneece River's driving privileges will be suspended for a period of one (1) year from the date of this judgment.
