

behalf of clients and using her licensing number to seek reimbursement of services rendered by an unlicensed person;

IT IS FURTHER STIPULATED AND AGREED that her conduct constitutes multiple violations of the IFPA and that any future violations of the IFPA shall be considered a subsequent violation;

IT IS FURTHER STIPULATED AND AGREED that Defendant Wright shall pay a sum of \$26,250.00 ("Settlement Amount") to the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance, which consists of civil penalties in the amount of \$25,000.00 in accordance with N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b, and a \$1,250.00 surcharge in accordance with N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1;


IT IS FURTHER STIPULATED AND AGREED that immediately upon execution of this Stipulation of Settlement by Defendant Wright, Defendant shall remit to the attorney for the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking & Insurance a payment in the amount of twenty-six thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$26,250.00), made payable to "Commissioner, New Jersey Department of Banking & Insurance" in a certified check, money order, or attorney trust account check;



IT IS FURTHER STIPULATED AND AGREED that the signing of this Stipulation of Settlement resolves all issues between the parties.


