#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The format of this report has been updated to capture data for cases with in-person proceedings as well as more data for those with "on-the-papers" proceedings. Pursuant to changes in the applicable regulations, the PIP arbitration rules were amended and Forthright began accepting filings of on-the-papers cases on March 1, 2013. Therefore, this report includes data for the first full quarter of on-the-papers cases. Throughout this report, in-person cases may be designated as "IP" and on-the-papers cases may be designated as "OTP."

In the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2013, 14,529 cases were initiated in the PIP ADR program. Of these cases, 7,685 (53%) were filed in the Northern region, 2,163 (15%) in the Central region, and 1,895 (13%) in the Southern region, and 2,786 (19%) as OTP.

During the quarter, the DRP panel consisted of 60 members. The DRPs were regionally deployed as follows: 41 in the North; 9 in the Central; 10 in the South. 13,739 cases were assigned to DRPs.

Of the pending cases in the PIP arbitration program, 15,324 were concluded during the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter by means of an award or denial of award (including appeals), pre-hearing dismissal of the case, settlement, or withdrawal. There were 788 cases placed in abeyance by consent of the parties or by order of the court.

System-wide, the average amount awarded in arbitration (excluding filing fees) was \$4,757, comprised of \$3,959 for personal injury protection benefits and \$798 for attorney's fees per case. It is common practice for users to stipulate that amounts awarded by DRPs are subject to further reduction for deductibles, copayments, prior payments, and/or medical fee schedule adjustments. In such cases, the final amount paid by the respondent for PIP benefits may be less than the awarded amount.

Twenty-three (23) appeals to panels of 3 DRPs were concluded during the reporting period. Eighteen (18) involved awards or dismissal orders rendered in the North Region, three (3) in the Central Region and two (2) in the South Region. Forty-four percent (44%) of appeals resulted in some form of modification.

The number of Medical Review Organizations increased to four with the addition of Rising Medical Solutions. During the reporting period, parties requested 107 (MRO) reviews. DRPs did not request any reviews. The requests were apportioned among the four MROs on a rotating basis.


#### **CASES INITIATED**

Cases are considered "filed" as of the date a Demand for Arbitration is received by Forthright. Case "initiation" occurs when an initiation letter is transmitted to the parties.

Cases which qualify for "in-person" ("IP") proceedings may be filed in one of the three regions — Central, North or South. They are assigned to a DRP with an office within the geographic location. Cases that proceed "on-the-papers" ("OTP") are not region specific and may be assigned to any DRP. Throughout this report data are reported as OTP or IP. Regional breakdowns of data describe IP cases only and will bear the designation of "IP — [region]".

In the  $2^{nd}$  quarter of 2013, 14,529 cases were initiated in the PIP ADR program. Of these cases, 7,685 (53%) were filed in the Northern region, 2,163 (15%) in the Central region, and 1,895 (13%) in the Southern region, and 2,786 (19%) as OTP. See the table below for the monthly distribution.

#### TRANSFER OF CASES FROM OTP PROCEEDINGS TO IP PROCEEDINGS

Under certain circumstances, cases that were initially filed as OTP may be transferred to IP proceedings. The circumstances include consolidations (automatic, by consent or by request), insurance policy issues identified by respondent, cases voluntarily filed as OTP (but the respondent does not consent) and change of claim. Please consult arbitration Rules 6, 9 and 51 for a complete explanation of the circumstances for transfer. The table below shows the number of cases transferred in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter and the reason.

### **DISPOSITION OF CASES IN THE PIP ARBITRATION PROGRAM**

Of the pending cases in the PIP arbitration program, 15,324 were concluded during the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter by means of an award or denial of award (including appeals), pre-hearing dismissal of the case, settlement, or withdrawal. The table below illustrates the manner in which cases were administered and concluded in the three IP geographic regions as well as the OTP category. The designation "N/A" appears in the table because pre-hearing dismissal is not an option for OTP cases.

### **CASES SETTLED WITHIN 45 DAYS OF INITIATION**

The respondents are granted a conciliation period of 45 days from case initiation in which to settle claims without incurring the respondent administration fee.

The following table expresses the distribution of settlements within 45 days of initiation.

\*Note: This data is based only upon user communications describing cases as settled or resolved. There are likely cases that the parties communicated as "withdrawn" or otherwise concluded which were actually settled and would qualify for this category.

#### **DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROFESSIONAL CASELOAD**

During the quarter, the DRP panel consisted of 60 members. The DRPs were regionally deployed as follows: 41 in the North; 9 in the Central; 10 in the South. 13,739 cases were assigned to DRPs.

Caseload activity of DRPs is represented in Appendix A. The appendix had been modified to distinguish in-person cases from on-the-papers cases.

#### **DISPOSITION OF CASES AFTER DRP ASSIGNMENT**

OTP cases are assigned to a DRP upon initiation. IP cases are assigned to DRPs following expiration of the 45-day conciliation period. After DRP appointment, a total of 14,304 cases were resolved during the quarter, resulting from a combination of DRP-issued awards (which includes denials and appeals), prehearing dismissals, settlements, and withdrawals.

The following table represents the distribution and outcomes of cases across the entire DRP panel during the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2013 after the cases were assigned to DRPs.

#### **REGIONAL AWARDS' PERCENTAGE**

As shown above, a total of 5,720 awards were issued by DRPs concerning requests for expedited relief, standard relief, fee disputes, and appeals. Of the awards issued, 72% were in the North region, 14% in the Central region, and 14% in the South.


#### AWARDS AS A PERCENTAGE OF CLAIM AMOUNT

DRPs can deny a claim in its entirety or award all or part of an amount requested by a Claimant. For cases decided in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2013, the graph below indicates the distribution of DRP total awarded

amounts, from 0% (denied/dismissed) to 100% of claimed amounts. Total awarded amounts include PIP benefits, legal fees and costs.

For purposes of the data table and chart below, amended amounts are captured within a total amount claimed and then compared to the total amount awarded.



#### PIP BENEFITS AND ATTORNEY'S FEES COMPARISON

System-wide, the average amount awarded in arbitration (excluding filing fees) was \$4,757, comprised of \$3,959 for personal injury protection benefits and \$798 for attorney's fees per case. The graphical representation compares the data as percentages.



### AWARD AVERAGE, MEDIAN AND DOLLAR RANGE

The average amount awarded for claims other than attorney's fees and costs was \$3,959\* per case. Awarded amounts ranged from \$0 to \$405,495. The median award during the reporting period was \$996.

The average amount awarded for attorney's fees was \$798 per case. Awarded attorney's fees ranged from \$0 to \$5,750. The median attorney's fee award during the reporting period was \$1,000.

### **APPEALS**

Thirteen (13) appeals to panels of 3 DRPs were concluded during the reporting period. Seven (7) involved awards or dismissal orders rendered in the North Region, two (2) in the Central Region and four (4) in the South Region. Thirty-one percent (31%) of appeals resulted in some form of modification. The following table reports the results.


#### **MEDICAL REVIEW ORGANIZATION REPORT**

There are currently four Medical Review Organizations certified by the Department of Banking and Insurance. They are ExamWorks, formerly known as CFO Medical Services, First Managed Care Option ("FMCO"), Support Claim Services ("SCS") and Rising Medical Solutions. Information relevant to MRO usage is outlined in the table below.

#### ONLINE CASE MANAGEMENT AND AWARD SEARCHING

This section of the report provides usage data for Forthright's free web-based case management tools for PIP practitioners located online at www.nj-no-fault.com. Forthright completely re-designed and enhanced the functionality of the user web portals as a free customer service. PIP practitioners now access a "dashboard" from which they can navigate through their case information. They can retrieve and view both parties' document submissions as well as access rules and forms, file and manage cases online, upload case documents, and search prior decisions.
