




Organization for NGOs working throughout Watershed



National Context




Legislative History

- Stakeholder-driven process begun in 2008
- First introduced in House in Feb. 2010
 - Original sponsor: Rep. Castle
 - Current sponsor: Rep. Carney
- First introduced in Senate in June 2011
 - Sponsored by Senator Carper
 - Hearing in 2012
- Re-introduced in all sessions since



DRBCA Overview, Part 1



- Creates a Delaware River Basin Restoration Program in the U.S.
 Fish & Wildlife Service
 - Non-regulatory
- Requires consultation with agencies & states to identify and prioritize activities
 - DRBC, USACE, EPA, NOAA,
 NRCS, PDE, States, others

DRBCA Overview, Part 2

- Creates competitive grant program
 - State/local agencies, non-profits, universities
 - Federal share up to 50%
- \$5 million authorized in House & Senate bills
 - At least 75% for grants & technical assistance
- Affirms Basin is a national priority





- Planning, Monitoring & Research




Current Status



- House (H.R. 1772) & Senate (S. 921)
 bills are identical and were reintroduced on 4/14/15
 - H.R. 1772 has 17 co-sponsors
 - S. 921 has 6 co-sponsors
- H.R. 1772 was heard by Water,
 Power & Oceans Subcommittee
 on 7/23/15

Next Steps

- House: Mark-up before full House
 Natural Resources Committee
- Senate: Hearing before Fisheries,
 Water & Wildlife Subcommittee
- House & Senate: Identify Packaging Options
