To Whom it May Concern:

As the DRBC wrestles with the issue of regulation in regard to hydraulic fracturing within its' boundaries I think it is important to be aware of some new technology which may well enhance the safety of the process.

The Lamnipipe process (please see our web site www.lamnipipe.com) holds the promise of binding released radionuclides (uranium, radium, radon) to the interior of the pipe at a depth of thousands of feet. As a result the withdrawn Flowback Water should be largely radiation free.

The treatment of waste Flowback Water would be simplified and safer. Water containing radioactive nuclides would no longer be sent to waste treatment facilities or recycling units; only suspended solids, salts and other chemistry would need to be dealt with.

I would welcome any opportunity to discuss this in detail with the appropriate people at DRBC and feel strongly that such a process should be evaluated and mandated for water used in the process. The radioactive particles would remain permanently at the lower portions of the well riser.
